Re: Pharmacy network change effective 7/1/11
Walgreens and CVS Pharmacies removed from Health Plan Pharmacy Network

The following is the content of the notification letter mailed to all Plan A and B members in Ingham, Ionia, Livingston and Mid-Michigan Health Plans in May, 2011:

“Beginning July 1, 2011, Walgreens and CVS Pharmacies will no longer be in the pharmacy network. This will be a cost savings to you and to the Health Plan.

If you get medication from these pharmacies you should transfer your prescription (s) to another pharmacy before July 1. To do this:

- *Call or go to a pharmacy other than Walgreens or CVS*
- *Give them the Rx number on the medication label(s)*
- *Ask the new pharmacy to transfer the medicine to their pharmacy*

If you get your medicine at Walgreens or CVS after July 1, you will be responsible for the full cost of the medicine; not just the co pay amount.
